

DTaP Immunization Rates in Philadelphia, 2014

Infants (19-35 months) ≥ 4 doses of DTaP Vaccine by Zip Code

In 2014, Philadelphia's citywide DTaP infant immunization rate was 83.8%. Most zip codes have rates greater than 80% and less than 90%.

Center City had the lowest DTaP coverage for infants in 2014, ranging from 57.1% (19103) to 63.4% (19106).

The highest DTaP infant immunization rate in the city for 2014 was in South Philadelphia 88% (19148).

DTaP Vaccine Philadelphia Data

According to the National Immunization Survey published on August 28, 2015, the city of Philadelphia's 2014 DTaP (≥ 4 doses) infant immunization rate (85.6%) is slightly above the national average (84.2%) and slightly below the state average (87%).

Both Philadelphia and Pennsylvania are above the national average, but still below the Healthy People 2020 goal of 90% coverage.
