

Hepatitis A Immunization Rates in Philadelphia, 2014

Infants (19-35 months) ≥2 doses of Hepatitis A Vaccine by Zip Code



Philadelphia's citywide hepatitis A infant immunization rate is 69%. On average, most zip codes have rates greater than 60% and less than 80%. The one exception is Center City, which has the lowest rates in the city between 52% (19103) and 58.2% (19106).

The highest hepatitis A infant immunization rate in the city for 2014 was in South Philadelphia 79.8% (19148).

According to the National Immunization Survey published on August 28, 2015, the city of Philadelphia's 2014 hepatitis A (≥ 2 doses) infant immunization rate (59.8%) is slightly above the national average (57.5%) and slightly below the state average (61.9%).

Both Philadelphia and Pennsylvania have averaged about 58% coverage of ≥ 2 doses of hepatitis A for infants over the last five years.
