

# KIDS Plus IIS

## Bi-Directional Interface



KIDS Plus IIS will send an immunization history for a patient as a response to an incoming query originating from your Electronic Health Record (EHR) system. Providers can receive up-to-date immunization data while the patient is in the office.

Check that patient demographic information is up-to-date with each patient encounter. It may take a few minutes to receive a response to a query message during peak office hours.

You will be able to import KIDS Plus IIS records when there is an exact patient match by applying all of the following criteria:

1. First and Last name
2. Date of Birth (DOB)

It is preferred, but not required that you supply:

3. Medical Record Number (MRN)
4. Mother's maiden name
5. Gender

## Vaccine Duplications

Vaccine duplications may occur in cases where individual antigens are reported to KIDS Plus IIS instead of the combination vaccine. For example, three records for each individual antigen DTaP-HepB-IPV may be returned instead of a single record for Pediarix.

Vaccine duplications may occur in cases where there is discrepancy for DTP vs. DTaP or IPV vs. OPV records.

- DTP (pertussis whole cell form) was primarily administered in the U.S. prior to 1996 and is currently administered to patients outside of the U.S.
- OPV (Oral Polio) was primarily administered in the U.S. prior to 2000 and is currently administered to patients outside of the U.S.
