

Rotavirus Immunization Rates in Philadelphia, 2014

Infants (19-35 months) Up-to-date on Rotavirus Vaccine by Zip Code

An "up-to-date" infant has completed either the 2-dose Rotarix or 3-dose RotaTeq recommended schedule

Philadelphia's rotavirus immunization rates vary by region, with the highest coverage in the South and Northwest, and lowest coverage in the North and Near Northeast. West and the Far Northeast are in between with rates just above 50%. Center City coverage varied between 47% (19107) and 68% (19106).

The highest immunization rate was in the Northwest (19128) with 79%. The lowest rate was 46.1% in North Philadelphia (19133).



According to the National Immunization Survey published on August 28, 2015, the city of Philadelphia's 2014 rotavirus infant immunization rate (70.0%) is slightly below the national average (71.7%), but the city's rates have a 7.5% margin of error.

Philadelphia's rotavirus immunization rates have not dramatically changed in the last five years.
