



The Importance of Alarms



How to Identify an Alarm

If you see the word ALARM above the temperature, then there was an alarm. The black boxes under the temperature indicate that there was an alarm on a previous day. Now you must respond.



If you see an alarm, you must respond to it. Please remain vigilant of alarms when you do your twice daily temperature recordings. It can get complicated to try to respond to a week-old alarm.

How to Respond to an Alarm

Immediately download the data onto your computer. You must download the data to reset the unit. After downloading, send it to the Philadelphia Immunization Program ASAP. Wait for our response. Some excursions may require you to contact the vaccine manufacturers.
