Providers: Re-enroll In the Vaccines for Adults At Risk Program

The Philadelphia Department of Public Health announces a re-enrollment period for the Vaccines for Adults At Risk (VFAAR) Program. The Philadelphia VFAAR Program requires participating health care providers to complete re-enrollment paperwork every year.

Being a VFAAR provider in Philadelphia allows your practice to offer certain vaccines to certain Philadelphia adults at no cost to you.

Complete the attached form to continue your participation

To re-enroll in the program, complete these steps:

1. Complete all 7 pages of the attached VFAAR Enrollment form
2. Have your Vaccine Coordinator and Back-up Coordinator complete the CDC training *Immunization: You Call The Shots - Module Ten - Storage and Handling - 2017* here: <http://www2a.cdc.gov/nip/isd/ycts/mod1/courses/sh/ce.asp>
3. Have your Medical Director complete the KIDS Plus IIS Confidentiality Agreement: <http://kids.phila.gov/index.php/documents/kids-plus-iis-user-confidentiality-agreement/>

Submit the forms to the VFAAR Program

You must complete all the steps and submit all paperwork by November 17, 2017. If you fail to do this, you will be suspended from the VFAAR Program and KIDS Plus IIS.
